Post-GA	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Support for SSH services with multiple FQDNs● Support for FQDN with multiple hosts (e.g., login1, login2)● Support for ssh_config to identify Globus Auth SSH hosts and store desired account mapping● SSH ControlMaster support● SSH Jump Host support (ssh -J)● Multi-hop support (ssh login1 then ssh login2)● Moving FQDNs between SSH service hosts
