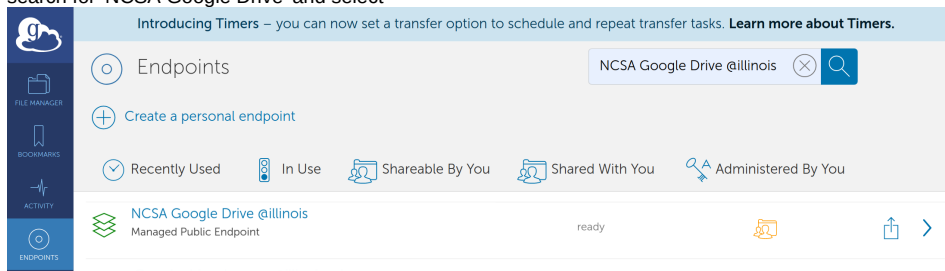


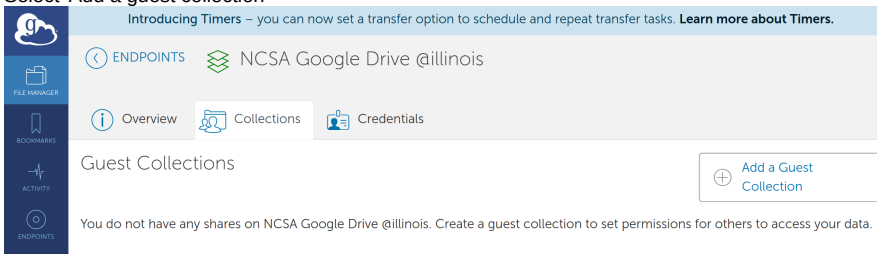
Create Google Drive Collection on NCSA Google Drive @illinois

NOTE: A Globus "Collection" in the new Globus Connect Server v5 (GCSv5) is what has previously been referred to as an "endpoint". The Display Name created in step 11 will be used to access this collection through the Globus webui or cli.

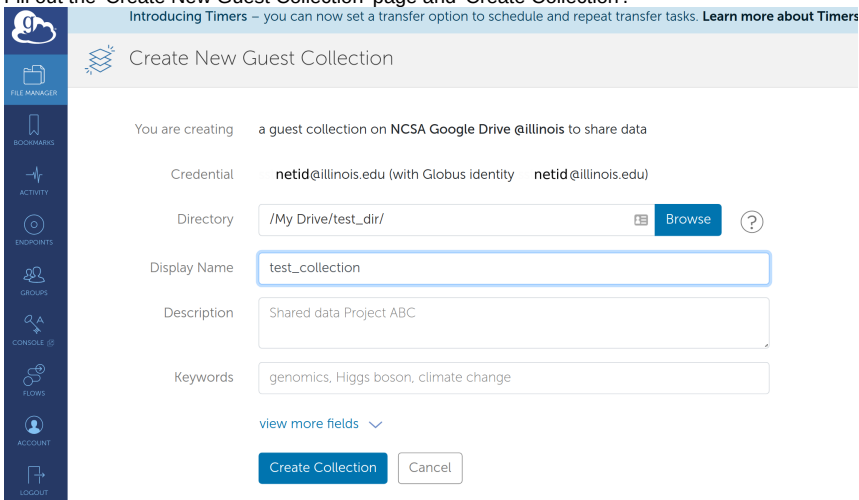
1. Logon to <https://globus.org>
2. If you have not, please first go through the steps here: [Access NCSA Google Drive @illinois through Globus](#)
3. Select 'Endpoints' from the left navigation bar
 - a. search for 'NCSA Google Drive' and select



4. Navigate to the 'Collections' tab from the NCSA Google Drive @illinois endpoint page
5. Select 'Add a guest collection'



6. Fill out the 'Create New Guest Collection' page and 'Create Collection'.



7. Add permissions for other Globus users who should have access to the collection.
