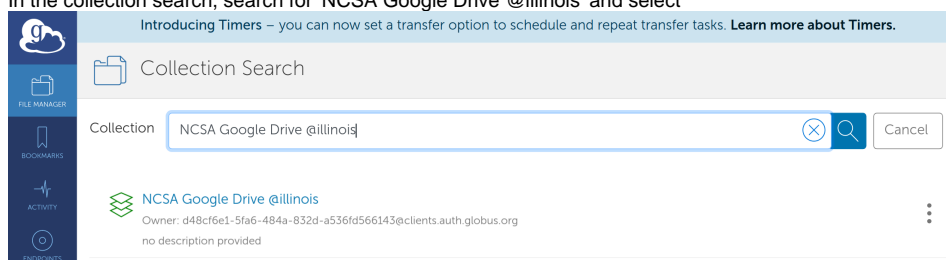


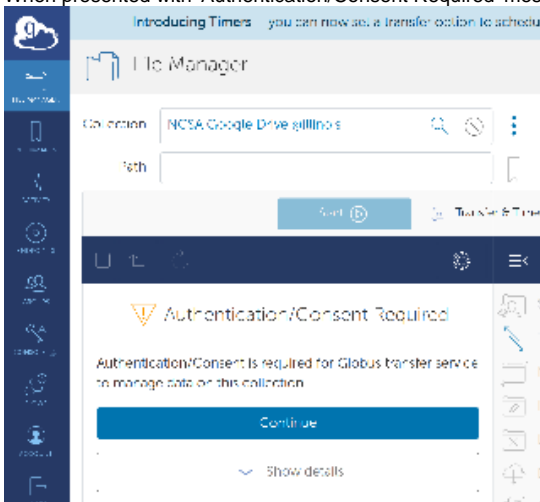
Access NCSA Google Drive @illinois through Globus

NOTE: A Globus "Collection" in the new Globus Connect Server v5 (GCSv5) is what has previously been referred to as an "endpoint".

1. Logon to <https://globus.org>
2. Select 'File Manager' from the left navigation bar
 - a. In the collection search, search for 'NCSA Google Drive @illinois' and select



3. When presented with 'Authentication/Consent Required' message, select 'Continue'.



4. Select an illinois.edu identity or Link one with your Globus account.



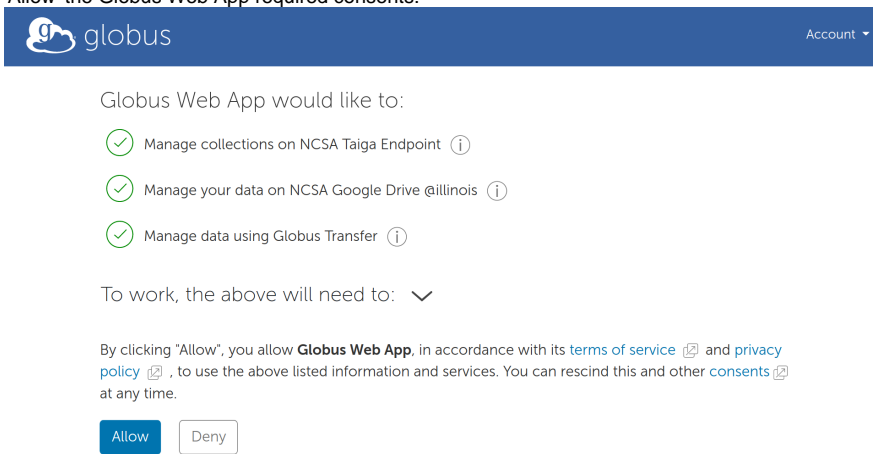

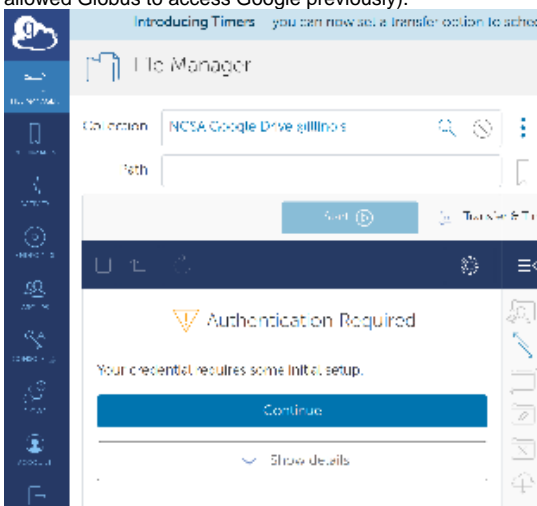

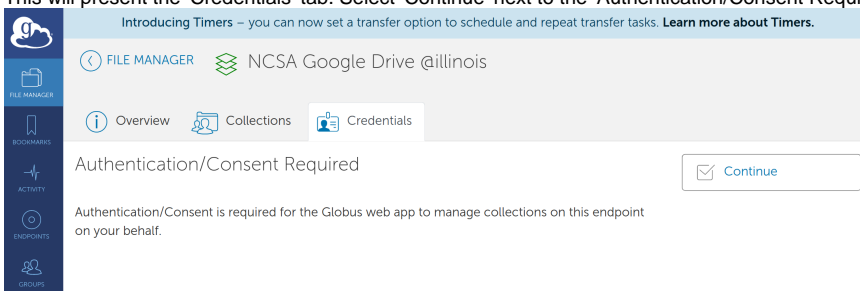
5. 'Allow' the Globus Web App required consents:



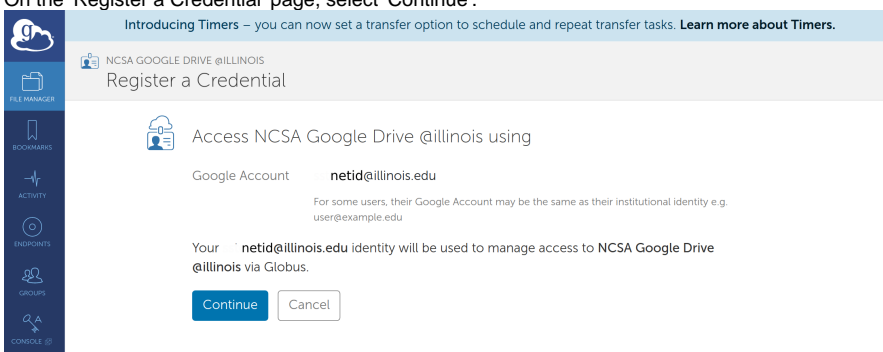
6. Select 'Continue' on the 'Authentication Required' message dialogue. (This message may be slightly different depending on whether you've allowed Globus to access Google previously).



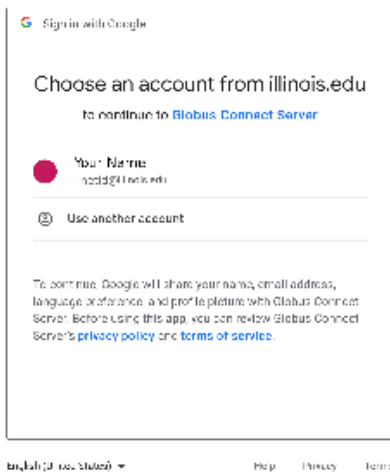
7. This will present the 'Credentials' tab. Select 'Continue' next to the 'Authentication/Consent Required' message.



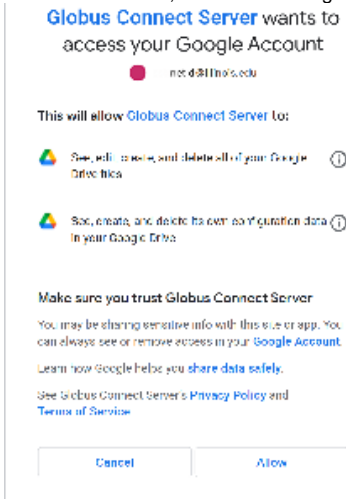
8. On the 'Register a Credential' page, select 'Continue'.



9. This will bring up a 'Sign in with Google' dialogue. Select the appropriate Google (illinois.edu) account.



10. In the next window, select 'Allow' to grant Globus the required access.
